Ezekiel Ch 38:1-6 The Gog Magog War

38 The word of the Lord came to me:

*2 “Son of man, set your face against **Gog (Prince of Rosh)**, of the land of **Magog**, the chief prince of **Meshek and Tubal**; prophesy against him*

*3 and say: ‘This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I am against you, **Gog**, chief prince of **Meshek and Tubal**.*

4 I will turn you around, put hooks in your jaws and bring you out with your whole army—your horses, your horsemen fully armed, and a great horde with large and small shields, all of them brandishing their swords.

*5 **Persia, Cush and Put** will be with them, all with shields and helmets,*

*6 also **Gomer** with all its troops, and **Beth Togarmah** from the far north with all its troops—the many nations with you.*

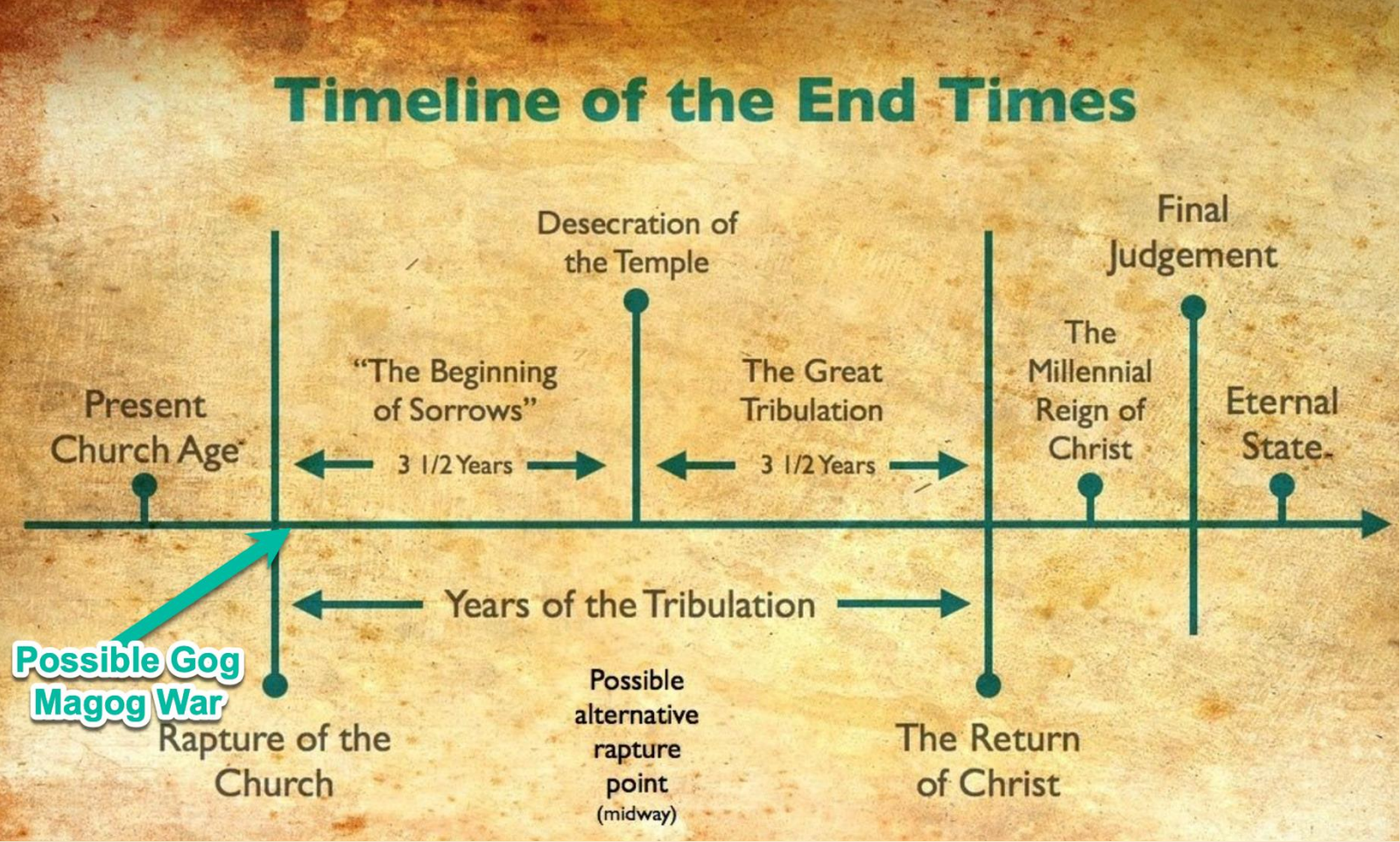

- Ezekiel lived in the same era as Daniel and was a captive of Babylon
- 3 main prophecies
 - Dry Bones – Return of Israel
 - Future End Times Battle
 - God's judgment against Gog/Magog
- Details given of war and aftermath
- Nations identified

Genesis 11:1-4 The Tower of Babel

11 Now the *whole world had one language and a common speech.*

2 As people moved eastward, they found a plain in Shinar and settled there.

3 They said to each other, **“Come, let’s make bricks and bake them thoroughly.”** They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar.

4 Then they said, **“Come, let us build ourselves a city, with a tower that reaches to the heavens, so that we may make a name for ourselves; otherwise we will be scattered over the face of the whole earth.”**

Disobedience and defiance of God’s commands

Genesis 11:5-9 Confusion and Scattering

⁵ *But the Lord* came down to see the city and the **tower** (migdal) the people were building. ⁶ The Lord said, **“If as one people speaking the same language, they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them.**

⁷ **Come, let us go down and confuse their language so they will not understand each other.”**

⁸ **So the Lord scattered them from there over all the earth, and they stopped building the city.**

⁹ *That is why it was called **Babel**—because there, the Lord **confused** the language of the whole world. From there, the Lord scattered them over the face of the whole earth.*

Genesis 11:10-17

Shem to Peleg

¹⁰ This is the account of Shem's family line.

*Two years after the flood, when Shem was 100 years old, he became the father of **Arphaxad**.*

¹¹ And after he became the father of Arphaxad, Shem lived 500 years and had other sons and daughters.

*¹² When **Arphaxad** had lived 35 years, he became the father of **Shelah**.*

¹³ And after he became the father of Shelah, Arphaxad lived 403 years and had other sons and daughters.^[e]

*¹⁴ When **Shelah** had lived 30 years, he became the father of **Eber**.*

¹⁵ And after he became the father of Eber, Shelah lived 403 years and had other sons and daughters.

*¹⁶ When **Eber** had lived 34 years, he became the father of **Peleg**.*

¹⁷ And after he became the father of Peleg, Eber lived 430 years and had other sons and daughters.

The genealogical pattern of earlier in Genesis comes back

Genesis 11:18-25 Peleg to Terah

¹⁸ When **Peleg** (division) had lived 30 years, he became the father of **Reu** (friend).

¹⁹ And after he became the father of Reu, Peleg lived 209 years and had other sons and daughters.

²⁰ When **Reu** had lived 32 years, he became the father of **Serug** (intertwined).

²¹ And after he became the father of Serug, Reu lived 207 years and had other sons and daughters.

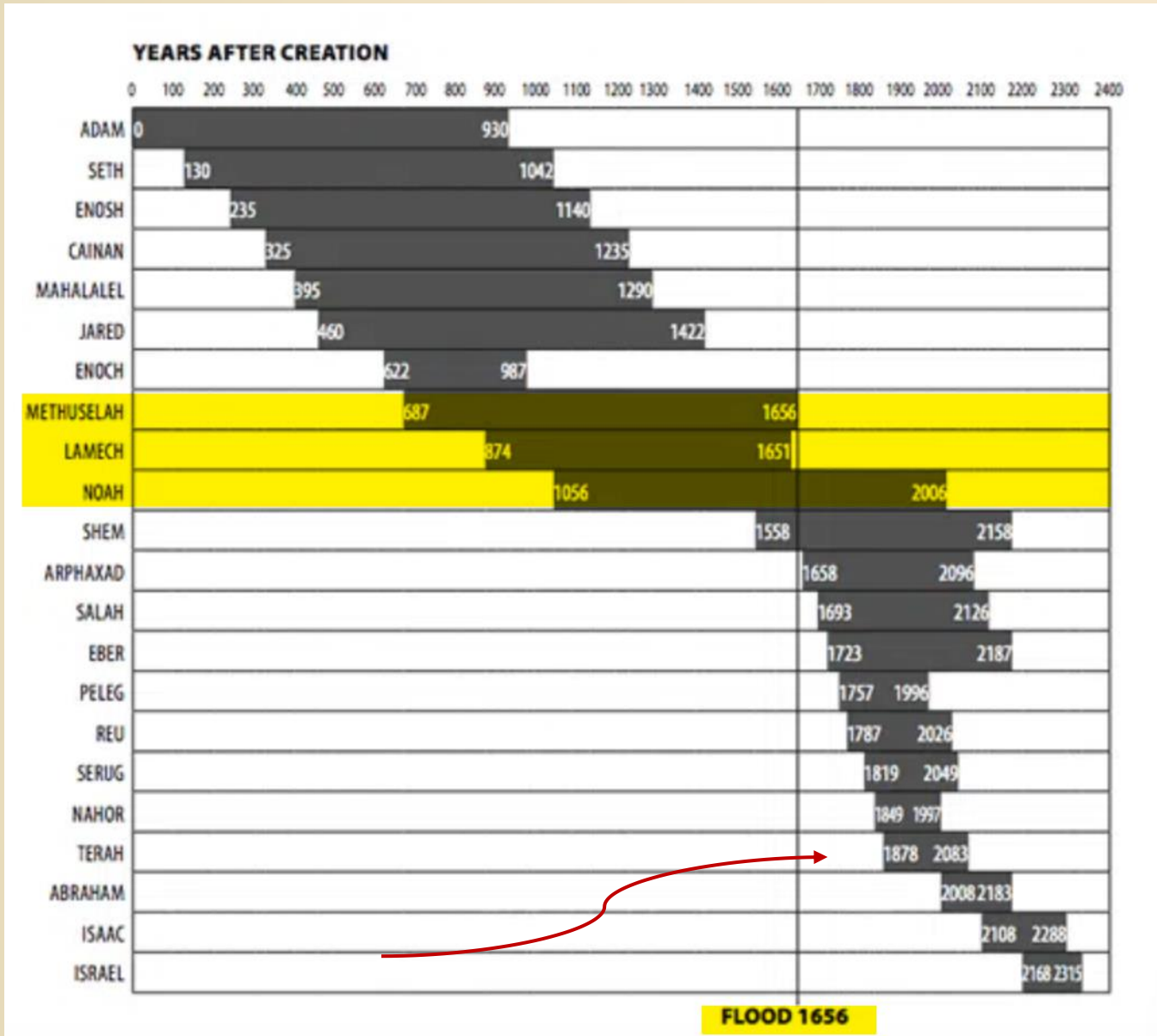
²² When **Serug** had lived 30 years, he became the father of **Nahor** (hot or scorched).

²³ And after he became the father of Nahor, Serug lived 200 years and had other sons and daughters.

²⁴ When **Nahor** had lived 29 years, he became the father of **Terah** (patient breath/wanderer)

²⁵ And after he became the father of **Terah**, Nahor lived 119 years and had other sons and daughters.

Genesis 11: Where Terah fits in...



- Terah is the father of Abram
- Abram = Abraham, the father of Isaac and Ishmael
- Isaac is the father of Jacob and Esau
- Jacob is Israel and the father of the 12 tribes of Israel

Genesis 11:26-30 The 3 sons of Abram

*²⁶ After Terah had lived 70 years, he became the father of **Abram, Nahor and Haran**.*

Abram's (exalted Father/ Shield) Family

²⁷ This is the account of Terah's family line.

*Terah became the father of **Abram, Nahor** (hot/scorched), **and Haran** (mountaineer). And Haran became the father of **Lot** (cover/envelop).*

²⁸ While his father Terah was still alive, Haran died in Ur of the Chaldeans, in the land of his birth.

*²⁹ **Abram** and **Nahor** both married. The name of Abram's wife was **Sarai** (princess), and the name of Nahor's wife was **Milkah** (queen/counsel); she was the daughter of Haran, the father of both Milkah and Iskah (weave a cover).*

*³⁰ Now **Sarai** was **childless** because she was not able to conceive.*

Genesis 11:31-32 The Journey begins...

*³¹ Terah took his son **Abram**, his **grandson Lot** son of Haran, and his **daughter-in-law Sarai**, the wife of his son Abram, and together they set out from Ur of the Chaldeans to go to Canaan. **But when they came to Harran, they settled there.***

³² Terah lived 205 years, and he died in Harran.

Terah takes Abram, Sarai, and Lot on a journey to Canaan, but when they stop in Haran, they decide to settle there, and Terah dies there. Now it is Abram, Sarai, and Lot and their possessions, animals, and slaves
